

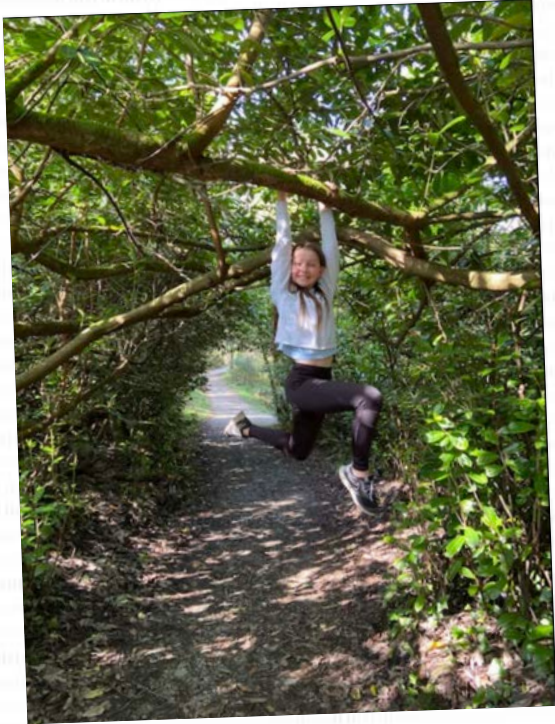

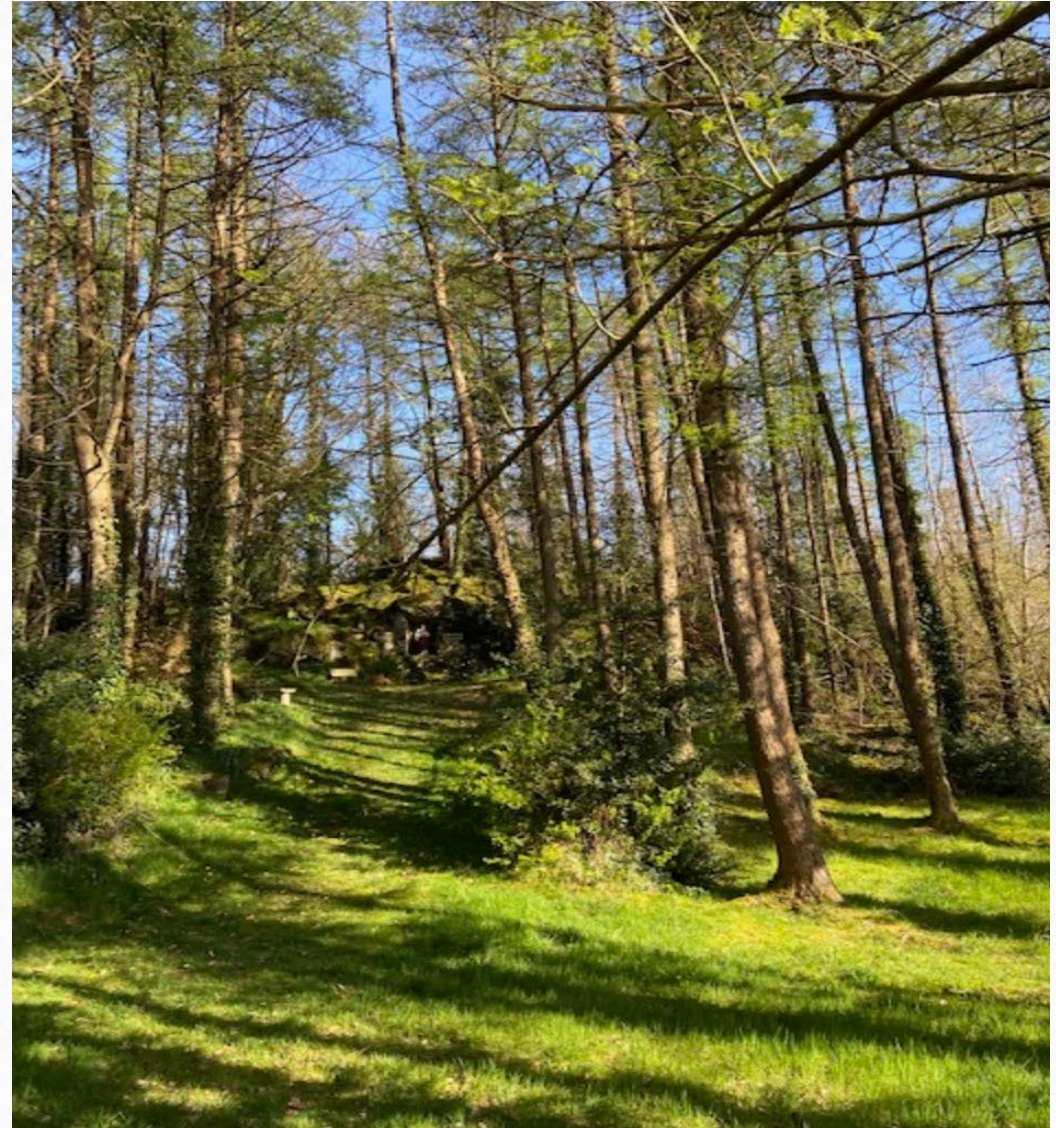

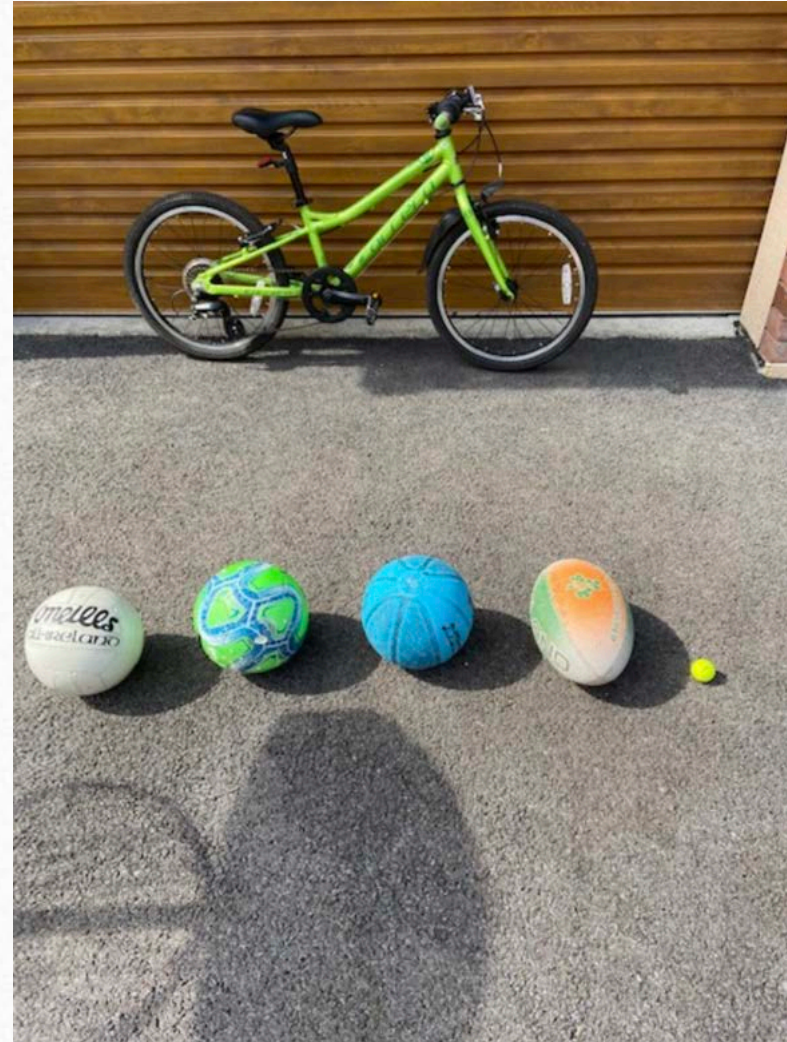




# My Iconic Image

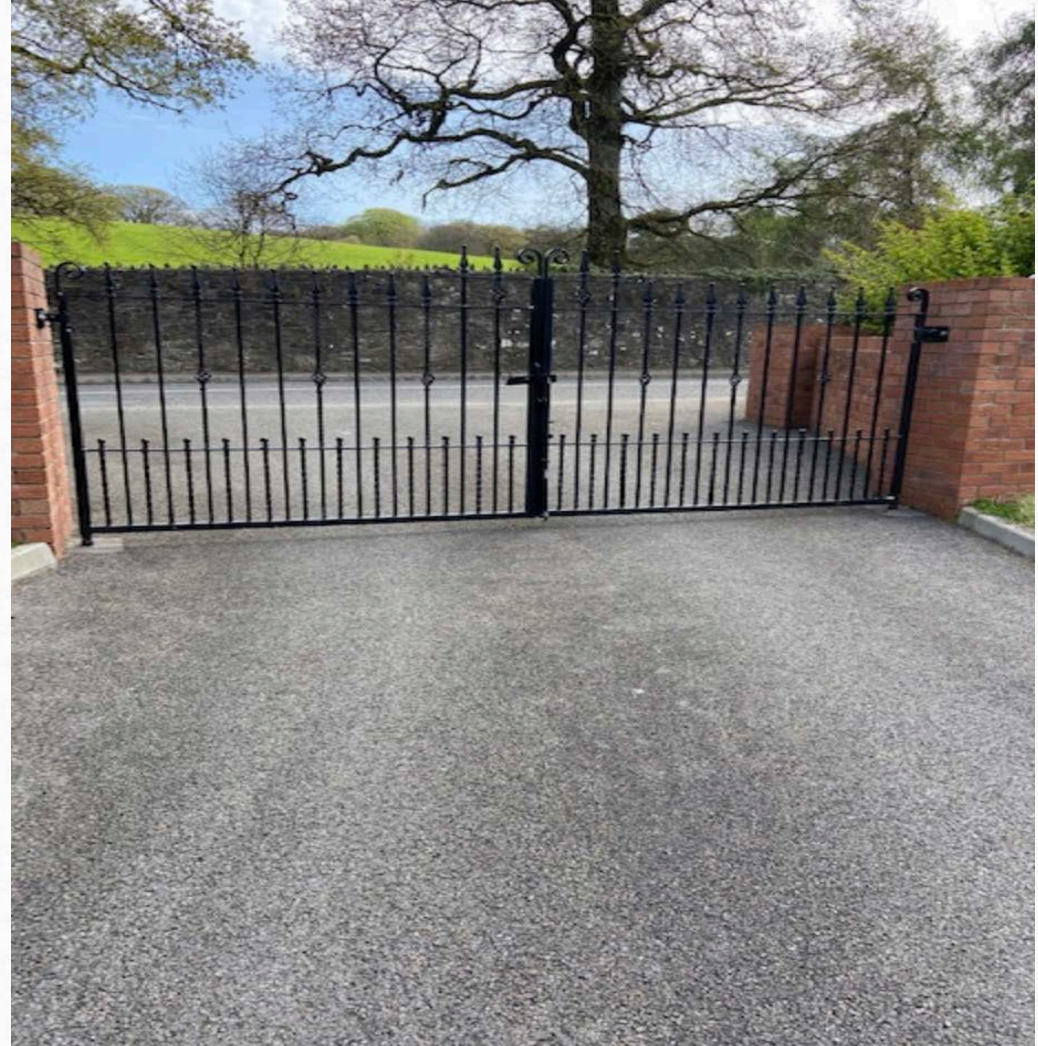




# My Iconic Image

Dear future self ...

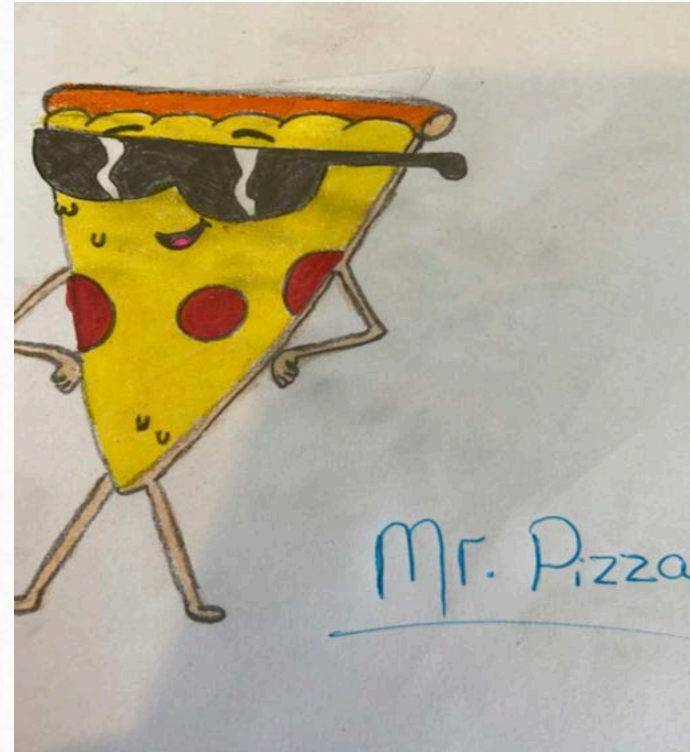
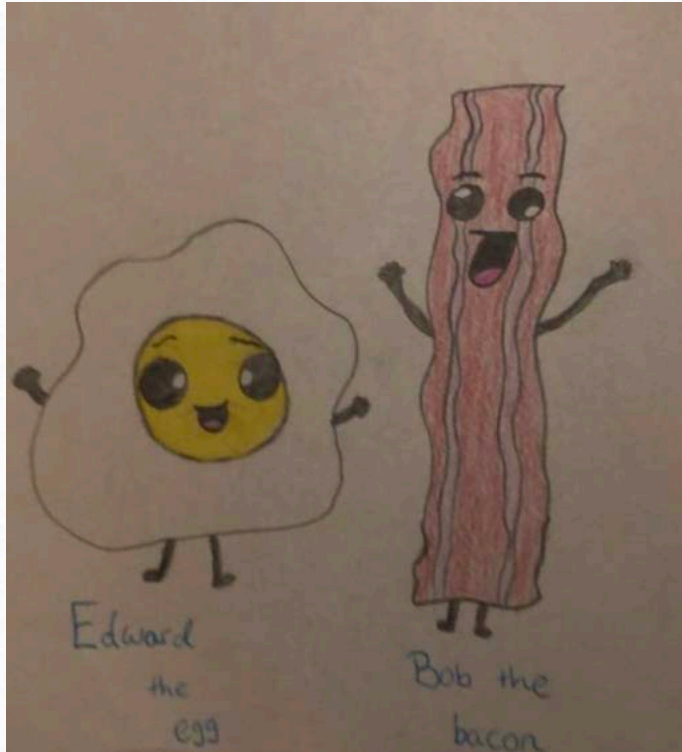

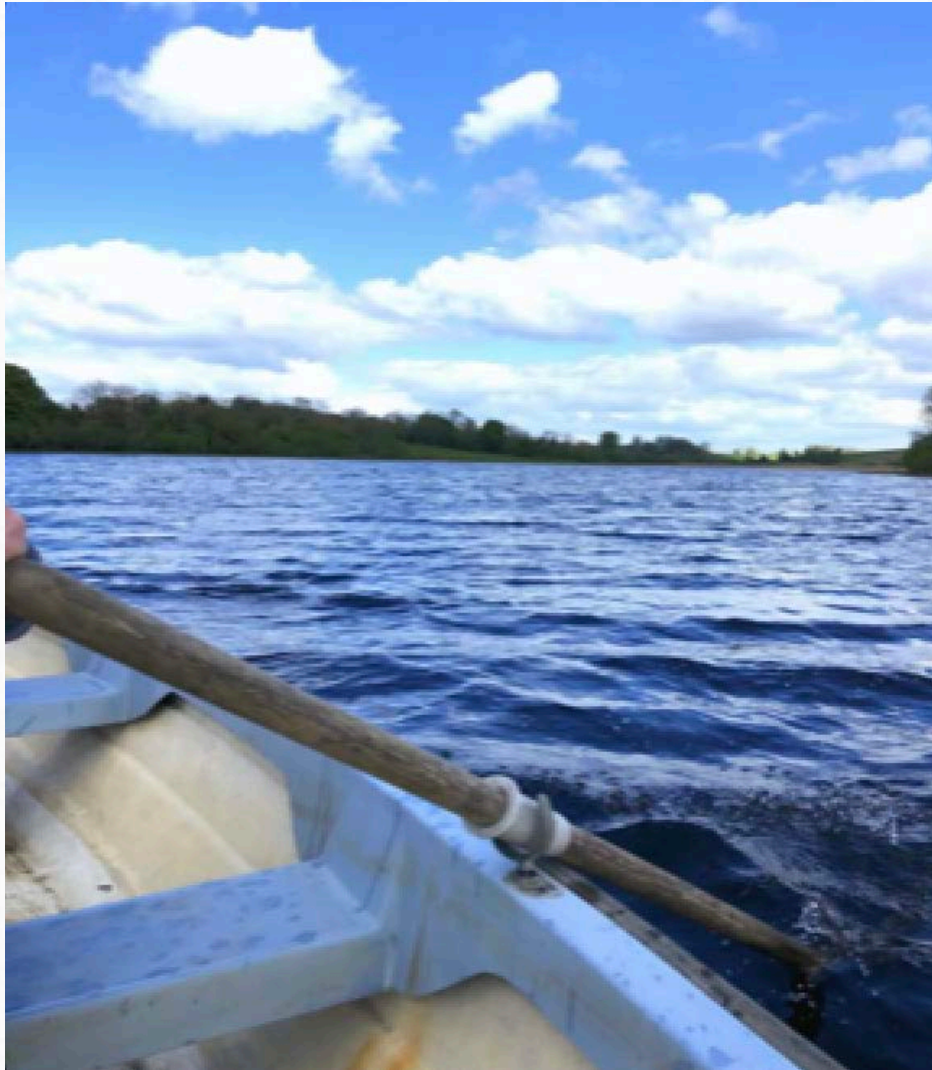

This photo was taken when I was out on a boat with my family on Killybandrick lake, very close to our home.

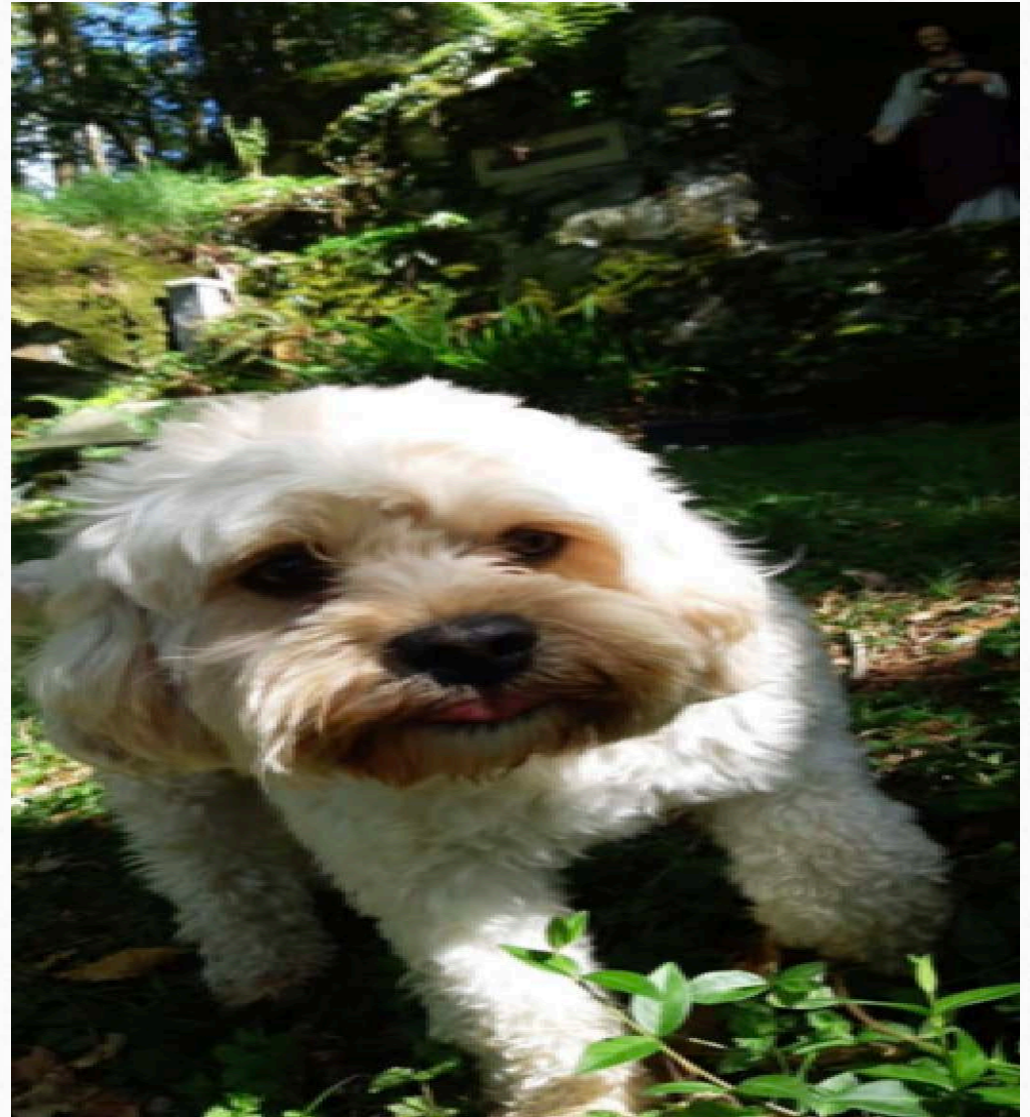

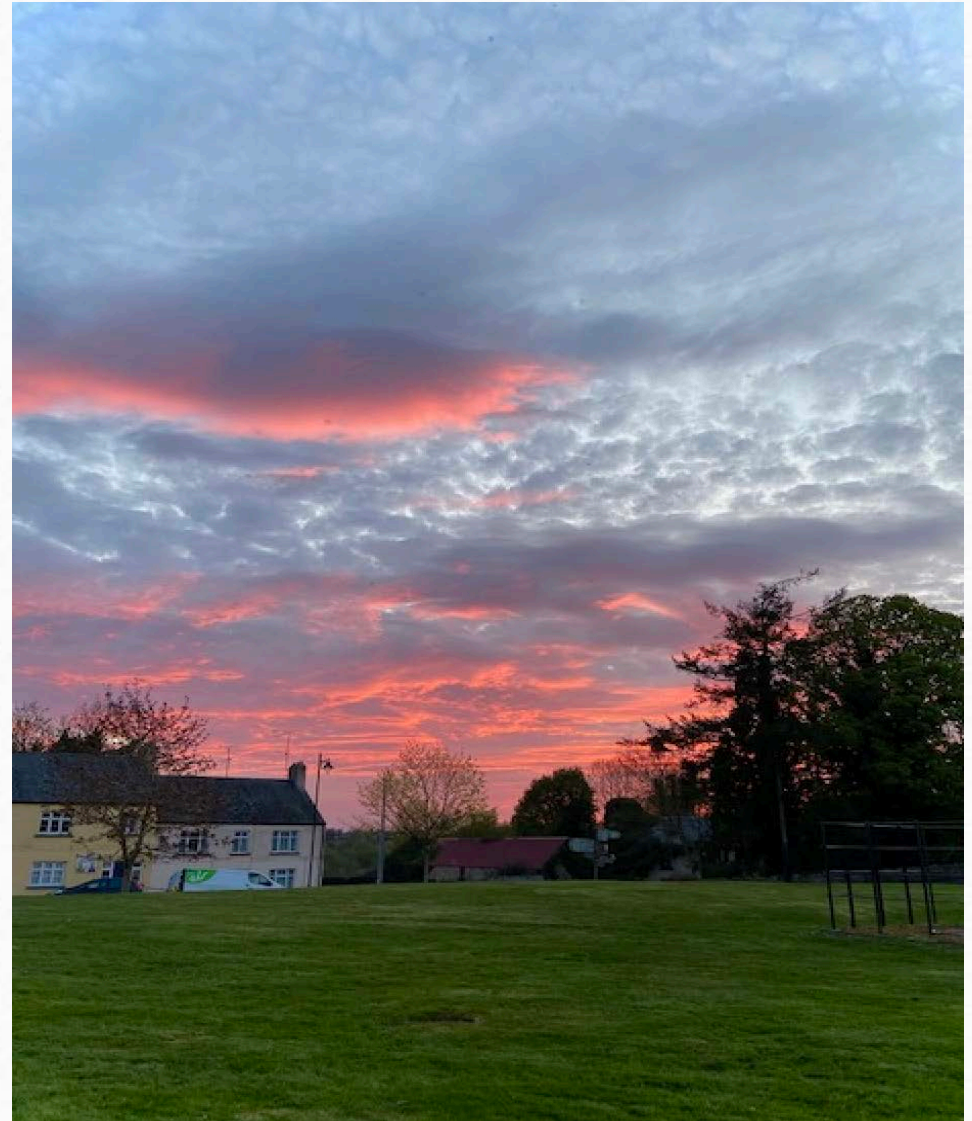

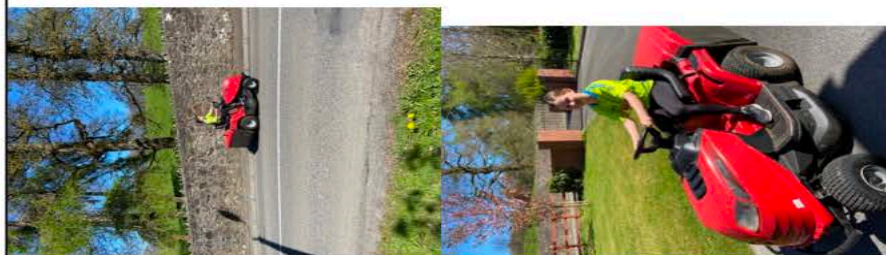
